“Law review of 2011: a legal update”

2011 saw a number of interesting and significant legal decisions. Julian Cohen's talk focuses on a number of these that are of particular significance and relevance to the construction and engineering industries.

The subjects covered include:

- delay and extensions of time;
- performance bonds;
- contractual issues affecting construction contracts;
- effective dispute resolution

Whilst analysing the legal issues and decisions, Julian will also talk about the practical issues and implications that arise in connection with these cases for the industry.

This presentation will be valuable to those involved in the industry as well as those advising parties.

Julian Chen is a barrister with Parkside Chambers here in Hong Kong. He has more than 20 years of specialist experience of heavyweight construction disputes, domestic arbitration and international commercial arbitration. In addition to acting as counsel in Hong Kong and regionally, he also sits as an arbitrator. He was called to the Bar in England in 1990. He has been in Hong Kong since 1998. Prior to returning to practice at the Bar in 2010, he was a Partner in the Construction and Engineering Department of Pinsent Masons in Hong Kong.
