I enclose a renewal of membership invoice to enable members to renew their membership of the Society before the Annual General Meeting, which will be held on Monday, 21 June 2010.

Membership of the Society brings a number of benefits, including reduced rates for events and no charge for some functions during the year. We have reciprocal rights with the UK Society of Construction Law and have access to their website which, together with the Hong Kong website, contains some 240 papers on a wide range of construction law issues. This is an excellent pool of information available only to members.

Moreover, this year the Society is hosting the International Construction Law Conference from 5 to 7 December at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre.

Membership to the Society will allow you also to:

- Ensure that you receive information on the events held throughout the year, many with high profile visiting speakers on current topics of interest.
- Ensure that you have access to the committee members so that your views and ideas can be relayed to the committee, helping to ensure that the Society is representing the wishes of all those interested in Construction Law.

This year we offer again an inclusive fee entitling you to attend all events, except the one-day conference, for free. Members can decide not to opt for this and simply pay the basic renewal fee and pay for individual events. The usual event price for members is \$100 and for non-members it is \$200 (excluding the International Conference). The Society averages an event per month, typically 11 technical sessions and one social event. The fee for this option is \$880 whereas the basic fee is \$650.

I am sure that you will recognise the value in such a membership and I attach a renewal notice and invoice for your information.
