The one-day Forum provides a platform for the local and overseas experts in the following areas to share their views and experience with the construction related practitioners:

1. **Competition Law:** Aims to provide a legal framework to curb anti-competitive conduct. It introduces two broad prohibitions against anti-competitive agreement and concerted practices and abuse of market power. This Forum will introduce the Competition Law to industry stakeholders and highlight some of its potential implications for the Hong Kong construction industry.
2. **Security of Payment:** Recommendation for the enactment of legislation in Hong Kong to address longstanding payment issues within the construction industry.
